Weekend Impaired Driver Rehabilitation Program (IDRP)

IDRP formerly known as CRASH

The weekend IDR Program is held at Northeast Kingdom Human Services at 2225 Portland Street, St. Johnsbury Vermont.

The program begins at 3:00 p.m. on Friday of the scheduled weekend and ends on Sunday at 12:00 p.m.

- Participants are responsible for arranging transportation to and from the program.
- Participants are responsible for making their own hotel reservations and paying for those separately.
 - The Comfort Inn provides overnight accommodations at a discounted rate. When making reservations just ask for the IDR rate from Northeast Kingdom Human Services. Their contact number is (802) 748- 1500

Our program serves individuals that need to complete requirements for DUI#1 and DUI #2 only. If you are being charged with 3 or more DUI's you are not eligible for the Weekend Program. Please contact NKHS at (802) 748-1682 for more information.

According to State requirements you may be required to attend further counseling. For First time offenders this treatment program must consist of a minimum of 4 hours and 4 sessions, and they must continue over a minimum period of 4 weeks. Second time offenders are mandated to attend a minimum of 20 sessions, over a minimum of 24 weeks. Your counselor must be an Licensed Alcohol Drug Counselor. If you received your DUI in another State you must check with them to see if they will accept Vermont's program.

Overview of Impaired Driver Rehabilitation Program (IDRP)

IDRP is a State of Vermont program designed to provide education on substance abuse and driving under the influence (DUI) for those convicted of a DUI 1 or 2.

Northeast Kingdom Human Services offers a weekend IDRP Program to eligible participants. **Individuals with a LIFE suspension are not eligible for participation in the weekend program.** The weekend program includes the intake evaluation, the IDRP educational program and the determination of whether or not further treatment is recommended. The program begins on Friday afternoon, continues all day Saturday, and ends on Sunday afternoon.

This weekend IDRP program is offered at NKHS 2225 Portland Street St Johnsbury Vermont.

If treatment is required, the individual must successfully complete a treatment program with a Licensed or Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor. The IDRP Evaluator will explain the process and requirements to the individual.

Successful completion of the weekend IDRP program is determined by:

- Completing the weekend IDRP education course successfully
- Attend School Exit

For license reinstatement you will need to complete the recommendations of the IDRP evaluator. And all state requirements.
